From the Desk of Pastor Ginny

Dear Friends,

The earth is the Lord's and the fullness thereof. That's how I learned Psalm 24:1. This week, I found myself reflecting on that, and even beyond it: Not just the earth: but the whole universe is the Lord's, and all there is.

Wow! Probably like me, you paid attention to the full solar eclipse this week. Probably like me you said: *Wow!* Watching TV coverage on Monday, I kept hearing that word: *Wow.* I know several of our folks had gone to visit family or friends in the path of the eclipse, so they will have more to say about the experience. I expect them to use these words: *wow* and *awesome* and *amazing*. Maybe even *incredible!*

Here are some things I was noticing. First, in places where the eclipse was total or near-total, the eclipse affected everyone: rich or poor, young or old, immigrant or long-time resident, male or female, gay or straight. Each person had the chance to see the darkened sky, feel the sudden cooling, experience the incredible effect of moon's orbit intersecting the earth's orbit of the sun. (Do I have that terminology right?) There's no status, no condition favored by the experience: it is there for all. It's like grace. Free and open for all God's children. The earth is the Lord's. There to be enjoyed and studied and marveled at by all God's people.

The other thing that intrigued me was what I heard several times: that, as far as our scientists can figure out, the earth is the ONLY place in the universe where a planet's moon can pass between the planet and the star it orbits. A solar eclipse, when it happens, is totally unique in all creation. Now that's like you; you are totally unique in all God's creation. Me too; I am totally unique. And God made us, God loves us, God knows who we are, and God saves us.

I'm back where I started, my friends. I'm ready to say the word once again. You can say it with me: *WOW*. Just: WOW.

Thanks be to God. Thanks be to our amazing God.


