From the Desk of Pastor Ginny

Dear Friends,

I am eager to share with you what I consider really important news. The Session at its meeting this week approved a new Mission Statement for First Presbyterian St. Pete. It was developed by a group of 10 church leaders, representing the Session, the Deacons, and the Pastor Nominating Committee. This group represented all ages, all lengths of membership, both worship services, and people both tall and short. I'm not sure if we had any lefties, or any red-heads...but we tried for a good mix of First Church peeps. Their work reflected much of what the church has talked about over these last two years through *Extraordinary Time*, *The Road Ahead*, and *Sailboat Church*.

Anyway, here is YOUR new Mission Statement:

First Presbyterian Church seeks to be a welcoming beacon of Christ's love, so all people may experience God's beloved community through connection, healing, and renewal.

I hope you will begin to think about the many dimensions of this statement. Let it speak to you about our ministry and our church, about ways the message of Christ's love might be seen and shared with this community and through each of us. I will offer a sermon series in May and June to develop themes I see in this one sentence. Committees and ministries will be invited to ponder ways to make this statement more and more true in their work.

In Lectio we sometimes ask about the Bible texts we are exploring: Where are YOU in this passage? I now ask you to consider: Where are YOU in this Mission Statement? Where does this statement call out to your heart, to your need? Where does it call you to live out your faith for others? Where might we each be called to stretch and grow because of truths emerging in these words?

It's food for thought. This gives room for the church to explore, again, just who we are called to be. I plan to join you in this exciting, important conversation. Meanwhile, be safe and healthy. See you at church!




Theological Scholarships

Health Kits and Healthy Teeth for Honduras For Our Next Mission Sunday On May 19, 2024

Our Mission Committee is once again partnering with our Honduras team for their upcoming trip June 9-16, 2024. For this Mission Sunday, we need toothbrushes for both adults and children.

We also need spooled dental floss, waxed or unwaxed (but *NOT* the plastic "pick" kind that can create litter in Honduras).

Also needed are Band-aids for adults and children. And if you're unable to bring any of these items, \$\$money\$\$ will work just fine (make checks out to FPC and mention Honduras trip in the memo line).

Collection boxes labeled "For Honduras" will be below each of the Giving Trees in the Youth Center and the Sanctuary.

The assembled health kits will be distributed in each of the five villages visited by our team where they perform health screenings for adults and offer activities for children.

So how can you help in addition to providing the items above?

Our Mission Committee needs many hands this Mission Sunday to remove all donated items from their packaging and then to bag the items in zip lock bags. As usual, committee members will be there to offer guidance.

- band-aids (for adults and children)

So come, enjoy your friends while assembling these health kits! Refreshments will be offered.

PLEASE NOTE: Also NOT needed are toothpaste and soap because of the additional weight to the Honduras team members' baggage. These items will be purchased in Honduras.


