Men's Meal Ministry Needs Your Support

Did you know that there are over 150 homeless men and women living at Pinellas Hope? What started out as a temporary emergency shelter in 2007, today it remains open and continues to help the homeless get off the streets.

With the support of your church, the men's meal ministry prepares nearly 200 hot meals each month for Pinellas Hope. Using the church kitchen in the Fellowship Hall, 6 to 8 men prepare over 80 pounds of meatloaf, servings of mashed potatoes, green beans, salad and a small dessert. The food is then delivered to Pinellas Hope and served by church volunteers. This is accomplished on a relatively small monthly budget of only \$500.
