

First Presbyterian Church is Honored by Pinellas School District

School Superintendent Michael Grego and Transformation Zone Chief Officer Nikita Reed praised First Presbyterian Church and other faith-based and community partners for the support the organizations have given this past school year to 12 Pinellas County schools with high-poverty populations. The recognition also celebrated the role played by community partners in the success of these schools.

First Presbyterian received a special recognition certificate at the district's community partnership celebration on Saturday, July 27, for its sponsorship of Lakewood Elementary School. The semester starting Aug. 14 will begin the second school year our church has provided mentors, reading buddies, school uniforms, food and much more to the families and staff of Lakewood. The church also recognizes the hard work of Lakewood teachers by providing them gift cards for such things as meals, movie tickets and Google Play.

The community meeting also shared the good news about the Transformation Zone schools' improved scores on this year's Florida State Assessment tests. Family and community engagement plays an important role in school performance, said Chief Transformation Officer Reed, who oversees the improvement efforts at these schools.


"I've never seen such consistent growth as happened in the Transformation Zone," said Dr. Grego. "Our schools are moving in the right direction," including Lakewood Elementary, which improved its performance on this year's Florida State Assessment by seven points.

"We need to celebrate Principal (Stephanie) Woodford for the tremendous amount of work she has done," said Dr. Grego.

"I'm so proud of the progress they've made," he said. "We''ll lock arms again" with all who support the school "and we'll be a 'C' next year."
