Background information for Interim Pledge:

In early December, everyone should have received a letter explaining that FPC is transitioning to a July 1st to June 30th budget year. This adjustment is being made to better match the budget cycle to the seasonal nature of our congregation. However, this time of transition leaves us with a fiscal gap between December 31, 2018, and July 1, 2019.



Because printing costs have become extremely expensive, personalized, printed envelopes will no longer be provided. If you wish to continue using envelopes for your offering, you are encouraged to use the ones provided in the pews. There is a place to write your name to ensure that your offering is properly credited.
