June 11 – July 23


You are invited to join us in the Youth Center on either


#### Weddings at First Presbyterian Church



Fresh Start Ministries and Mentoring (<u>freshstartmentorship.com</u>) is a faith-based non-profit organization mentoring non-violent, non-predatory men, women, and at-risk youth who are serving court-ordered probation under the supervision of the Florida Department of Corrections.

Mentoring is often required by the terms of probation and the need for women and men mentors is urgent, as the number of people adjudicated to probation in St. Petersburg has increased.
