Reception honoring Jack Rain in the Fellowship Hall after the concert



## Information from the Finance Committee on Qualified Charitable Distributions

For those who made Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCDs) to FPC from your IRA, please be aware that many financial services firms do not distinguish between charitable distributions and taxable distributions on the 1099R. In order to ensure that this tax strategy remains valid, the appropriate amount must be properly communicated to your tax accountant and/or entered into tax reporting software. Your financial advisor should be able to provide documentation, if required by your CPA. It is also important to note that, CPA's may not think to ask if you made a QCD so it is your responsibility to make them aware. FPC will include a comment on quarterly and annual contribution reports specifically stating QCD amounts gifted to the church.
