Honduras Mission Trip (June 9-16, 2019)

In just a few short weeks, 19 missionaries from FPC (including 4 youth) will travel to Honduras to conduct community health screenings for the New Hope Clinic and to provide children's outreach activities. They will also provide hygiene kits to adults and dental kits for kids. They are collecting the following:

The team also welcome monetary donations to purchase supplies in Honduras for things like soap & toothpaste, which are difficult and heavy to transport. June 11 - July 23


You are invited to join us in the Youth Center on either


Jessica and Andrew plan to be married in Naples during a Sunday morning worship service. Congratulations to them both and may God grant them a lifetime of joy and song.
