### HURRICANE DORIAN RELIEF YOU CAN HELP

Hurricane Dorian made landfall in the Bahamas as a Category 5 hurricane on September 1 and stalled over the islands for more than 24 hours, causing massive damage. So far, it is reported that seven lives have been lost.

Presbyterian Disaster Assistance is working with partners in the Bahamas to respond to immediate needs and is monitoring the storm as it heads along the Atlantic coast in the U.S.


